INFORMATION

FACILITIES: The FFA Leadership & Training Center (FFA Center) is located in the heart of Florida on the ancient scrub land of the Lake Wales Ridge, a quiet and peaceful place ideal for creating community for the Academy. Once you arrive, all activities are within a few steps of your villa, even the field trips.

LODGING: Lodging/meal package is for 2 nights. All double rooms are standard hotel rooms with 2 double beds. Triple and quad rooms are bunk rooms, each side with sink, bunks separated by a bathroom. Please identify people sharing your room; otherwise you will be assigned a roommate. No single accommodations available on site. Motels are available on US 27 15 miles from the FFA Center.

CAMPING: Primitive tent camping available at \$25/night; bathroom/hot showers available. Only self-contained RV's permitted; no hook-ups provided; \$25/night.

FOOD: Meal/lodging package includes Friday dinner, 3 meals on Saturday, and breakfast on Sunday, plus socials, and snacks/beverages at breaks. Please indicate vegetarian preference on registration form. The FFA Center boasts a 4-star chef and excellent food. No nearby restaurants.

BOATING OPPORTUNITIES: Kayaks and canoe rentals are available, or bring your own. Pontoon boat cruises, 1 hour on Lake Pierce, will be offered on Friday and Saturday late afternoon.
